Job Title: Housekeeping

Work Description: **Housekeeping** will be your primary job. This will include vacuuming, cleaning bathrooms and guest rooms, changing sheets, and making beds.

Note, although you will be filling support staff positions, English will still be a fundamental part of your job and so you are encouraged to practice your speaking and comprehension skills as best you can before arriving.

Uniform/Dress Code: There is no formal uniform needed for this job. You just need to bring neat and comfortable clothes, knee-length shorts and nice T-shirts. No sandals or open-toed shoes are allowed.

Salary Per Hour: \$8.00. You will also receive some cash tips from guests for good job performance.

Overtime Information:

Bonuses: There may be an ending bonus but you must abide by the work commitment dates your employer lays out for you.

Work Hours: You will be working between 30 - 36 hours per week. Please be aware that in the beginning, the motel will probably be less busy. Later in the summer, it will become much busier. You will probably not work more than 40 hours per week. Your employer can assist you in finding a second job in the area if you are interested in working more. However, your primary responsibility is to your InterExchange job.

Accommodation Cost: \$0

Accommodation Description: There is a required damage/cleaning deposit of \$100. This deposit is refundable at the end of your work commitment provided the apartment and bicycle are in the same condition as when you moved in. You will have to pay for telephone and internet access, if you want them in the apartment. Please contact the employer via email if you would like phone and/or internet service. You will be sharing a room with 1-2 other employees, and you will share a bathroom, living room, and full kitchen. The accommodations are located in a quiet area 1 mile from the job site. The area near the apartment is very quiet, not within walking distance to a town. Your employer will supply you with a bicycle which you can ride to work. Please be aware that you **MAY NOT SMOKE** in your accommodations or at work. No overnight guests are permitted. However, a swimming beach is located about 1 mile (1.6 km) from your apartment. A convenience store is within walking distance but there is limited bus transportation to the town of Chatham and other towns. The bus stop is a 2-3 minute walk from your apartment.

Job Title: Where needed.

Work Description: You will be assigned a position based upon the needs of your employer at the time of your arrival. You should be prepared to do any or all of the following: Housekeeping (changing linens, cleaning guests' rooms, doing laundry, vacuuming, cleaning bathrooms, changing sheets, making beds). Kitchen / Dishwashing (washing dishes, preparing salads, cleaning the kitchen, taking out garbage, mopping floors), Waitstaff / Bus Person (setting and clearing tables, assisting the waitstaff, serving food and drink, etc.), Maintenance. You may have a chance to work in other areas of the resort if there are openings in other departments. You should be flexible and ready to work in any area.

Uniform/Dress Code: You must always maintain a neat and clean appearance while on the job. For males, hair should not fall below the collar. No visible tattoos or body piercings except earrings. If a uniform is required, it will be provided by your employer. Some positions will require black pants, a white collared shirt, and clean, comfortable shoes.

Salary Per Hour: Starting at \$7.25 per hour. Some positions are tipped and you will be paid a base salary plus any tips you may receive. Expect a base of \$3.35 per hour.

Bonuses: \$1.25 per hour worked if you stay until Oct. 15

Work Hours: You will usually be working 8 hours per day; 5 days per week. 40 hours a week is guaranteed.

Job Title: Retail Salesperson

Work Description: James' Candy Company has stores in two locations: Atlantic City, New Jersey and Wildwood, New Jersey. Depending on the employer's needs, you could end up working in either location for the summer. Your duties will include: customer service and selling candy to customers, operating a cash register, stocking shelves, and labeling product at a candy store on the boardwalk.

Uniform/Dress Code: Employees are required to wear an apron (which is provided by our company). All employees must wear a black or white shirt with a collar. Pants/skirts can be black, khaki (light tan) or neat jeans (no holes, rips, etc.). If shorts or skirts are worn, they should be no shorter than one inch above the knee and should be black or khaki in color. Clothes should be clean without stains and odor. Employees are required to maintain a clean and neat appearance at all times. Men should be clean-shaven. All hair should be worn away from the face and long hair is required to be pulled back. If a hair style causes hair to fall in a person's face a hair net will be required to be worn. Nose, eyebrow and tongue rings are not allowed during working hours. Jewelry should be small and earrings cannot be longer than 1.5 inches in size. Shoes are required to closed toe, to be in good shape, and without tears and excessive wear. Note: Good English skills and American currency knowledge are a must. This job requires fluency to effectively communicate customers as well as the acquirement of American customer service skills.

Salary Per Hour: \$8.00

Overtime Information: Over 40 hours is paid at time and 1/2

Bonuses: At the end of your work commitment you will receive a bonus of \$35.00 for each week you worked if the following criteria are met: 1) Your last day of employment is within 48 hours of commitment date on your contract 2) You have consistently fulfilled the job requirements and have not had job fulfillment problems which would be written up as a formal write-up on a company Personal Action Notification Form.

Work Hours: 8 hours per day, five days per week. Work shifts are mostly in the evening but require flexibility for scheduling. Accommodation Description: A \$100.00 security deposit is withheld from your first 4 paychecks (\$25.00 per week). Your security deposit will be returned at the end of the work commitment if your room is left in a clean, neat condition without damage to the property. Your accommodation is located in a early 20th century house with three floors. The house is located behind the company headquarter building, about 300 feet from the boardwalk which is a direct walking path to our six Atlantic City retail locations. There will be approximately 10 InterExchange students living in the house. There is a common dining area, a living room with television, internet and three bathrooms. Laundry facilities are located on the first floor. You will be responsible for your own meals, you will have a refrigerator and microwave, and towels, linens will be provided.

Men's hair should be neatly trimmed on the sides and in the back, and may extend downward on the back of the head to the middle of the collar. No ponytails are allowed for men. Tattoos are not permitted if visible when wearing a company issued uniform. You may not cover tattoos with bandages or make-up. The company issued uniform is short sleeved.

Job Title: Cleaning Technician

Work Description: You will be cleaning our customer's homes, summer rental houses and commercial properties. Your duties will include cleaning kitchens, bathrooms, dusting, mopping, vacuuming living spaces, taking out garbage, washing laundry, doing some maintenance work, restocking toiletries, painting, cleaning windows, etc.

If you work hard and have a positive attitude, then you will succeed at this job. If you are a male, then you will most likely be doing more of the heavy duty work such as window cleaning which involves climbing ladders, so it is VERY IMPORTANT that if you are scared of heights you CAN NOT accept this job offer. You may also be doing some carpet cleaning, moving furniture, assisting with water restorations, resurfacing wood floors and other kinds of maintenance work. However, both males and females will do all duties if needed. On Saturdays, at the height of the season (July-August) everyone will be doing rental changeovers, which is cleaning of houses between the renters.

Uniform/Dress Code: Bring knee-length medium tan khaki shorts or long pants that sit on your waist. (Baggy pants/shorts, jeans or pants/shorts that sit below your waist are NOT ACCEPTABLE). This rule will be strictly enforced. Plus bring a pair of comfortable athletic shoes, NO SANDALS ARE ALLOWED. You will be given 1 T-shirt with the Company logo on it with no cost to you. You must maintain a neat and clean appearance every work day.

Salary Per Hour: \$7.50 during training and \$8.00 or more depending on your skills, speed and quality of your work. For some types of work you will be paid by the job, which gives you an opportunity to make more money depending on your production.

Overtime Information: N/A

Bonuses: N/A

Work Hours: You will usually be working about 6 hours per day, 4-7 days per week, depending on the load of work as well as the quality of your work. It works by a very simple pattern: if your work meets or exceeds our expectations and standards you will be given more hours but if it doesn't then we will need your help less. So, the amount of work hours depends on YOU and the amount of work we have at that time.

Accommodation Cost: 85

Accommodation Description: You will be living in a house next to the job office right near the ocean or in a house near the office (about 4 miles away). One of the houses is right near the beach, the other is across a bridge on the mainland. Your employer will tell you which house you will be living in upon arrival. If you live in the house across the bridge, you will be given rides to and from work everyday. There will be up to 5 people per room, and you will have a full kitchen and bathroom to be shared. If you are traveling with your boyfriend or girlfriend you will not be sharing a room. You will be responsible for your own meals. Your housing is simple but you will be near the beach or close by. Internet may be provided upon your request at additional cost. The cost would be divided up amongst all of the persons living in the house. Internet is provided at the office as a privilege.

ATTENTION!!! When you arrive you MUST pay rent for the next two weeks. After that, rent will be deducted from your paycheck bi-weekly.

Also, you MUST pay \$200 upon your arrival. \$150 of it will be held as a housing security deposit and \$50 will be used to buy for you 1 set of new bed sheets, 1 new pillow, 1 new towel and 1 extra T-shirt with the Company logo on it. You will be given 1 blanket at no cost to you. The housing security deposit in the amount of \$150 will be returned back to you on the day or your departure after you return the blanket back to us, clean the house you lived in and there will be no damage done to any appliance, any belongings of the house and/or the house by itself. Otherwise, we will deduct money from your security deposit enough to repair the damage.

HOW MUCH MONEY??? So, when you arrive you will need to have \$370 to pay for rent, security deposit and housing supplies and plus, you will need to have some money for food until you get your first paycheck.
